

MyQ Background

- Rate My Qualification (MyQ) and the Key Information for Students (KIS) are two new online information tools to help students explore their study options and find out more about a course or qualification to help them decide what to study. They are part of TEC's learners' product suite that collates information and seeks feedback to help inform students' study choice. MyQ has been developed for future students to help them decide what qualification to study.
- Rate my Qualification (MyQ) is a Ministerial initiative announced by the Government in 2015, and is part of the broader Better Public Services work Result 6– to increase the proportion of 25-34 year olds with advanced trade qualifications, diplomas and degrees. It was launched in December 2016.
- MyQ is aligned with the Tertiary Education Strategy 2014-2019 to improve outcomes for students, and links to industry, workplace and economy by providing the right information to help prospective students make informed study choices and career decisions.
- MyQ will complement the Key Information for Students (KIS) data by capturing information from graduates about how well particular qualifications prepared them for the workplace and their career goals.
- TEC has partnered with Careers NZ to deliver the KIS as a complementary product within their existing set of tools and services. The KIS data and the MyQ results will be made available on their website which is a key channel for prospective students to source their information.
