

# CIMS4

The CIMS4 practical two-day course is for those people who wish to advance their understanding of the Coordinated Incident Management System in a multi-agency environment in a SAR operation.

By the end of the CIMS4 workshop participants will have:

- Demonstrated the CIMS structure at incidents as a team member as indicated in the CIMS unit standards 29553 and 29554
- Demonstrate operational knowledge of CIMS structure, functions, and their interrelatedness
- Demonstrate operational knowledge of the Incident Management Team
- Describe function manager roles
- Describe the importance of planning transition to recovery phase during a response
- Establish and describe situational awareness in an incident
- Demonstrate knowledge of and contribute to planning an incident response
- Demonstrate and apply knowledge of briefings in a response

This course is a pre-requisite requirement for the *Extended Search Planning* and the *Manage the Marine Response* courses.
