

CIMS4

The CIMS4 practical two-day course is for those people who wish to advance their understanding of the Coordinated Incident Management System in a multi-agency environment in a SAR operation.



Pre-requisites: CIMS2

By the end of the CIMS4 workshop participants will have:

1. Demonstrated the CIMS structure at incidents as a team member as indicated in the CIMS unit standards 29553 and 29554.
2. Demonstrate knowledge of the inter-related functions of incident management to the model of coordinated incident management.
3. Demonstrate knowledge of Control function responsibilities.
4. Describe other incident management team (IMT) function manager roles in an incident.
5. Demonstrate knowledge of, produce and update an Action Plan in an incident.
6. Gain and convey situational awareness in an incident.
7. Demonstrate appropriate communication skills in an incident.

Course purpose: This course is a pre-requisite requirement for the Extended Search Planning and the Manage the Marine Response courses.
