

THREE DAY COURSE

Manage the Initial Response (Land)

This is a three-day course is for people who will be working in the incident management team for a land-based search and rescue operation. The course focuses on the management of the initial response phase of an operation.



Pre-requisites:
CIMS4 and Search Techniques

Course format: Some pre-course preparation. A mixture of theory lessons and scenario work based on real life case studies, building in complexity as the course progresses.

Topics include:

- Conduct search urgency assessment process for a search and rescue incident
- Use information to determine the initial response of a search and rescue
- Understand the use of Lost Person Behaviour in assisting search
- Develop plausible scenarios
- Develop initial search actions

This course is a pre-requisite for *Extended Search Planning*.
