



THREE DAY COURSE

Manage the Initial Response (Land)

This is a three-day course is for people who will be working in the incident management team for a land-based search and rescue operation. The course focuses on the management of the initial response phase of an operation.



Pre-requisites:

CIMS2 Search Techniques

Course format: Some pre-course preparation. A mixture of theory lessons, scenario work based on real life case studies, building in complexity as the course progresses.

Topics include:

- Describing the application of operational pre-planning.
- Conducting search urgency assessment process upon notification.
- Collecting information for the initial response.
- Applying lost person behaviour theory during an initial response period.
- Applying reflex tasking.
- Establishing and confirming the initial search area.
- Applying decision pointing.
- Assigning search and rescue resources during the initial response period.

This course is a pre-requisite for *Extended Search Planning*.
