

# Manage the Marine Response

This is a three-day course is for people who will be working in the incident management team for a marine-based search and rescue operation. The course focuses on the management of the response to a marine operation.



#### Pre-requisites:

1. Relevant in-house marine training with Coastguard NZ and/or NZ Police.
2. Marine SAR Technical
3. CIMS4

#### Topics include:

- Describe the factors affecting the initial response phase of a marine SAR operation.
- Conduct search urgency assessment process upon notification of a marine SAR incident.
- Discuss the use of a SAR readiness plan in the initial response.
- Apply initial actions during the initial response period of a SAR situation.
- Describe the role and function of the Incident Management Team in response to a SAR situation.
- Establish and define the initial search area during the first response period of a marine SAR situation.
- Develop and incident action plan following the initial response period of a marine SAR situation.
- Brief using the GSMEAC tool and assess risk.
- Tasking of SAR resources during the response period and action planning for a sustained response.
