

**TWO DAY COURSE**

# On Scene Coordinators

This two-day course introduces participants to the role of an On Scene Coordinator. It is for experienced SAR people who will be working in an Incident Management Team (IMT).

The course is to familiarise the SAR sector with the role of an On Scene Coordinator. (This course does not train people to be the On-Scene Coordinator.)



**Pre-requisites:**

CIMS4 and pre-approval from your relevant SAR agency

**Course format:** Some pre-course preparation. A mixture of theory lessons and scenario work based on real life case studies, building in complexity as the course progresses.

**Topics include:**

- Understanding the roles and responsibilities of the NZ Police in relation to SAR on scene coordination
- Knowledge of the principal SAR agencies available within New Zealand
- Understanding of the roles and responsibilities of the Rescue Coordination Centre New Zealand
- Knowledge of the NZ SAR Resource Database
- Knowledge of the roles and responsibilities of an On Scene Coordinator
- How to develop safety plans to mitigate risks
- How to develop communication plans
- Knowledge of how searches are suspended
