

**FIVE DAY COURSE**

# SAR Managers-Volunteers

This is a five-day programme is intended for experienced search and rescue personnel who may be delegated to perform planning, intelligence or operations management roles in a Police-led search and rescue incident response team.

Participants will join in week two of the Police SAR Managers programme. Volunteers from other SAR agencies will join the course to gain experience in the various roles of the Incident Management Team (IMT) supporting the Incident Controller.



## Pre-requisites:

- CIMS 4
- Manage the Initial Response
- Extending Search Planning
- Marine Search and Rescue Technical
- Manage the Marine Response

Some pre-course revision of the NZSAR Start Marine SAR modules, Search Area Determination (SAD) and Search Area Coverage (SAC) as well as the Marine SAR Technical.

You will take part in eight assessment tasks of simulated exercises/operations activities whilst performing an IMT function role (not Incident Controller). During the programme you will participate in land or marine scenario-based operations. The evidence of your competency arises from the activity you undertake whilst participating in Incident Management Teams in the Planning and the Intelligence management roles.

## Outcomes include being able to:

- Gather, collate, and analyse incident information
- Develop and implement an Incident Action Plan
- Maintain an Incident Action Plan
- Develop a demobilisation plan for the conclusion of an incident
