

SAR Managers

This is a ten-day course and is the last course to be completed by experienced NZ Police SAR personnel who will be delegated as the Incident Controller in a Police-led multi-agency search and rescue response.

For the second week, volunteers from other SAR agencies will join the course to gain experience in the various roles of the incident management team supporting the Incident Controller.



Pre-requisites:

1. CIMS 4
2. Manage the Initial Response
3. Extending Search Planning
4. Marine Search and Rescue Technical
5. Manage the Marine Response.

Some pre-course revision of the NZSAR Start Marine SAR modules, Search Area Determination (SAD) and Search Area Coverage (SAC) as well as the Marine SAR Technical.

You will take part in eight assessment tasks of simulated exercises/ operations activities whilst performing the role of an incident controller. There will be learning opportunities for you to demonstrate making operational decisions and completing the relevant documentation during a SAR operation as a SAR manager.

Upon completion of this course you will have demonstrated effective leadership techniques, established an Incident Management Team, planned a search and rescue response, implemented a search and rescue plan, resolved /suspended a search and rescue operation, and evaluated a SAR operation.
