

# Training for Delivery

This is a two-day course teaches the participants how to maintain a positive learning environment to maximise student learning and minimise barriers to this learning. The participant will learn how to prepare for, deliver and review training sessions.

The course is a mix of theory and practical with each participant preparing and delivering a short training session to their peers during the course. The participant prepares their training session on Saturday evening and presents on Sunday.

On successful completion and post course work, participants will obtain the following unit standards:

- 7115 – Create and maintain a positive learning environment for adult learners – Level 4-6 credits
- 7108 – Deliver on-job training for adult trainees – Level 4-8 credits

- Reflecting on the sessions
- Answering some theory questions
